Catherine Fitz-Gerald is a well-known South Australian artist recognized for her luminous oils and light filled abstracts. Over the years Catherine's works have focused on many themes and social issues including the slow food movement, food miles, mental health and climate change.

Primarily self-taught, Fitz-Gerald's early works celebrate abundance in the life surrounding us, inviting us to value fruit as more than something bought plastic wrapped from supermarkets. Her works remind us to seek the joy in each seasonal cycle.

Always inspired by nature and light her current work explores water and climate change. Using slices of light and simplified forms Fitz-Gerald's abstractions creates landscapes specific to time and place that are able to be 'anywhere'.

Catherine has participated in many group exhibitions as artist and curator and held many solo exhibition to great success. Her works can be found in private collections in Europe, Asia, USA and throughout Australia.
