Andrea Wilson has over thirty years experience in architecture and urban design. As director of the architectural practice simpson+wilson, she led the design and delivery of numerous high end private houses and community projects throughout NSW. In 2002 – 2004 as Councillor at the RAIA, she chaired the Sustainability Committee and authored the RAIA submission to the NSW Parliamentary Enquiry into Energy Efficiency. Andrea has worked for, and in association with, some of Australia's best known architects including Gold Medal Winners Richard Leplastrier, Glenn Murcutt and Ken Woolley. Through her work with her partner architect and urban designer, Roderick Simpson, Andrea has developed a clear understanding of the relationships between urban design and architecture and the knowledge that each requires a very different attitude.

Andrea has a keen interest in the sensorial nature of place and believes that architecture and urban places should strive to reflect and reveal the local qualities and characteristics of landscape, community and place rather than emulate the latest trends.

Andrea Wilson has recently extended her art practice to include exhibitions and entry into art competitions.
