## EARLY CIVILISATIONS—Plate 3—Babylon and Assyria



Between the rivers Tigris and Euphrates lies the plain of Shinar. The earliest inhabitants were known as Sumerians, but the land became known as Babylon, of which Assyria formed a part. Its history can be traced back beyond 3500 B.C.
