

Imogen Ashby is an award winning mixed media artist and Graphic Designer. Her ventures have taken her to London Fashion week, being the live artist at the VIP opening show of VIN+OMI in February 2019, to Prince Charles's Highgrove House, and has appeared on BBC News for her medical animation that helped raise over £7,500 for the charity Cardiac Risk in the Young. Currently, she is studying Graphic Design at Kingston University, and she has previously completed an Art foundation at Oxford Brookes University. As she is only young, her work is still very experimental and she therefore works in a range of mediums. The artwork Imogen creates has to have a message, and she thrives when combining both Medicine and Art to create outcomes that serve a purpose to help those around her. Recent projects include making chairs for waiting rooms out of otherwise wasted crutches, medical animations for children to understand their diagnosis, as well as general painting, illustrations and filmmaking. Bold strokes of system 3 acrylics, FW inks and aquafine watercolour are among those mediums used regularly in her work. Alongside her studies, Imogen works for Studio KT1.
